



ASSURED ENVIRONMENTAL; RENTAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1.1 Delivery & Collection

Where delivery and/or collection is unsuccessful, additional charges will apply.

1.2 Hire Period

The minimum hire period is stated in the Equipment Rental Agreement. Discounts may be available for extended hire periods. Contact Assured Environmental for details.

1.3 Duration / Extension of Hire Period

The duration of a hire is as stated on the Equipment Rental Agreement, and allowances are made for transit, weekends & public holidays. The equipment must be returned by the End date of the Agreement. Any extension must be authorised before the existing End date.

1.4 Payment Terms

Unless otherwise stated to the contrary elsewhere in the Agreement amounts invoiced to the Client by Assured Environmental shall be due and payable within fourteen (14) days of date of invoice by the Client. Goods and Services Tax will be applied at the applicable rate on the total of each invoice issued.

1.5 Expendable Items

Expendable items such as batteries are the responsibility and at the expense of the Hirer. All battery powered equipment is despatched with near new or charged batteries at the commencement of hire. It is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure battery charged has not been lost during freight.

1.6 Insurance

The Hirer assumes the entire risk of loss or damage including consequential losses to the equipment however sustained. The hirer must undertake to insure the equipment at his own expense.

1.7 Inspection and Receipt of Equipment

The Hirer will sign to acknowledge receipt of the equipment at delivery/handover. Any shortages, damages or defects should be notified immediately by telephone and/or email. Please provide photos where applicable so we can substantiate the issue at our end.

1.8 Modifications & Changes to the Equipment

Any attempt by the hirer to repair, modify or tamper with any equipment supplied for rental will render the hirer liable to a charge for reinstatement of the equipment to its original state and specification. The hirer undertakes to permit operation of the equipment by staff deemed capable of operating the equipment in a suitable and proper manner. The hirer undertakes to store the equipment in a suitable area and to take responsible care to mitigate the effects of water, heat, and other elements.

1.9 Termination & Ownership of Equipment and Goods

Assured Environmental retains the right to terminate the contract and repossess the equipment without affecting any rights to recover monies due, damages for breach of contract or other remedies where the Hirer is in breach or is involved in insolvency or liquidation proceedings. Ownership of the equipment remains with Assured Environmental.
